## **Guidance Notes for the completion of this application form**

1. This form is to be completed and signed by the prospective mortgagee or their representative.
2. Please complete the form electronically or in block capitals using black or dark blue ink.
3. When completed, the form should be forwarded to [aircraft@gov.im](mailto:aircraft@gov.im). The relevant fee may be paid over the telephone by credit or debit card, or alternatively charged to your account.
4. If the proposed mortgage covers more than one aircraft a separate entry should be made against each aircraft.
5. The Aircraft Registry will confirm an entry in the Mortgage Register by sending a letter detailing the relevant entry to all parties named overleaf and to the current registered owner.
6. Once accepted, a Priority Notice is valid for fourteen working days including the date of entry. To maintain priority, the contemplated mortgage must be made and entered in the Mortgage Register, or a further Priority Notice entered, within the fourteen working day period.
