



Dangerous Goods Approval

CARRIAGE OF ALCOHOLS, N.O.S. AND ETHANOL SOLUTION CARRIED IN THE AIRCRAFT CABIN AND FLIGHT DECK

01/2020

1. The Isle of Man Aircraft Registry in accordance with Part 1;1.1.2 and Part 1; 2.2.1(a) of the ICAO Technical Instructions¹ approves an operator, aircraft commander and all other relevant persons, only to the extent necessary to permit the carriage of Alcohols, n.o.s., UN1987 and Ethanol solution, UN1170, contained in hand sanitiser, in the aircraft cabin and flight deck.
2. This approval is granted subject to the following conditions:
 - a) the dangerous goods must be stowed and secured in the aircraft cabin and flight deck in such a manner that will prevent accidental spillage, damage or risk of fire;
 - b) the dangerous goods carried for replacement must be packed and secured in the aircraft cabin and flight deck in such a manner that will prevent accidental spillage, damage or risk of fire; and
 - c) the operator shall determine the maximum quantity of the dangerous goods required for the duration of each flight, including replacements. The net quantity of each single receptacle shall not exceed 0.5 Litres but for the purpose of this approval the total quantity shall not exceed 10 Litres.
3. This approval is issued to meet the urgent operational needs of a limited duration to unforeseeable circumstances as a result of the COVID-19 virus.
4. This approval is legally enacted in Isle of Man legislation by the issuance of an exemption from Regulation 5 of the Air Navigation (Dangerous Goods) Regulations 2002² which has effect from 28 May 2020 to 1 May 2021, unless revoked, suspended or varied.
